It is requested that this session does not exceed 16 minutes in total and that any member of the public shall not speak for more than four minutes. We ask that only one person speaks at a time and that any comments are directed to the chairman of the meeting. A question shall not require a response at the meeting nor start a debate on the question. The chairman of the meeting may direct that a written or oral response be given outside of the meeting if that is the most appropriate course of action.
